

## **The New Pharaoh of 2007 by Linda Small - Sadler**

### *Introduction*

In the year 2007 and in years to come there is a new Pharaoh in the United States of America and all over the world. The old Pharaoh of Bible days saw that the children of Israel were more and mightier than the people of Egypt were in terms of population size. So Pharaoh feared them.

So Pharaoh of 2007 does not have all power. The new Pharaoh of 2007 reports and answers to Satan, the CEO of evil.

The new Pharaoh of 2007 functional responsibilities are to put us in bondage, trap us, deceive us, set us up to fail and destroy all of God Chosen people.

So the new Pharaoh is a secondary executive. Allow me to use my imagination by saying that Satan and his secondary executive, Pharaoh of 2007 view all of God chosen people as the the corporation, company, organization, or Firm. 4 Edom (Pharaoh of 2007) may say, though we have been crushed, we will rebuild the ruins. But this is what the LORD Almighty says: They may build, but I will demolish. They will be called the Wicked Land, a people always under the wrath of the LORD. 5 You will see it with your own eyes and say, Great is the LORD, even beyond the borders of Israel.

*So whatever the LORD says or promises will come to pass (Small - Sadler, 2007).*

In Genesis 37, it reports that Joseph brothers sold him into slavery, yet Joseph, being 17 years old was one of the remarkable life stories of the Bible. Joseph was loved and hated, favored by his father, tempted and trusted. However at no point in his 110 ten years of life did Joseph ever lose his faith in The Lord. There was no amount of misfortune that unsettled Joseph's integrity. Joseph was the same in and out of season (Small - Sadler, 2007).

If Joseph's brothers had not sold him to the Midianites, then Joseph would have never gone to Egypt. If Joseph had never gone to Egypt, he would not have been sold to Potiphar and Potiphar's wife would have never falsely accuses him of rape, which landed him in prison.

### *People of Color increase the population*

According to the Emerging Minority Marketplace, Issued September 1999, and U.S. Department of Commerce U.S reports that America is a growing dynamic country whose population will multiply 50% over the next fifty years. Almost ninety percent of that increase will be in the Minority community.

The Minority Business Development Agency (MBDA) commissioned the Census Bureau to prepare this report on Minority Population Growth from 1995 to 2050. According to their report it shows that the minority community will be getting much larger.

The Census Bureau's estimates In addition to Hispanic, both African Americans and Asian populations got younger in 2006. The non-Hispanic white population was older than the population as a whole, with a median age of 40.5 compared to 36.4.

The S. Census Bureau found that 303 counties and parishes in the country are now majority-minority, meaning more than 50 percent of the population is made up of minorities (Contact Caitlyn Scott at [cscott@lsureveille.com](mailto:cscott@lsureveille.com)).

The Black population is projected to reach 61 million in 2050, an increase of 83 percent. From 2015 on, more Blacks will be added to the total population than non-Hispanic Whites every year. The American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut population also will nearly double, increasing 95 percent to more than 4 million people in 2050.

In 2030, the Minority population will exceed the non-Minority population at each age 0 through 5 years, with one-half million more Minority children in these ages than non-Minority children. By 2040, there will be 6 million more Minority population through age 21.

California's Minority population will surpass the non-Minority population, and the Minority population will represent more than 50 percent of the total state population in Texas by 2015.

These 5 states will represent one fourth of the total U.S. population...Adding the two most populous states of California and Texas. States include the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Remember God will not change His mind. He said that the meek will inherit the earth and no one can change God because the word says that God Changest Not . . . FOR I AM THE LORD, I CHANGE NOT.... Malachi 3:6;

While the National projections were prepared for the period 1995 to 2050, the state-level projections only cover the 30-year period, 1995 to 2025.

Non-Minority population at every age, 0 through 34, and the aggregated difference in these ages will be about 18 million. During the 55 years from 1995 to 2050, the Minority population under age 35 will more than double, from 43 to 100 million, while the non-Minority

population under age 35 will decline from 92 million to 82 million.

Even for ages 35 years and over, the difference between these two populations in 2030 will be reduced by 2050 for every age from 35 to 83 years.

The new Pharaoh of 2007 is very afraid that with the projection above that the tables will be turned.

The new majority will be People of Color with The Lord as the CEO and there is nothing anyone can do to change this report because it is in the Word of God.

The promises of God will come to pass and His promises will be realized. Pharaoh of 2007 will be forced to let God's people go because the meek cannot claim their inheritance in prison, can they (Small - Sadler)?

This writer remembers sending her brother a book of stamps and a 3-month-old Sunday school book and they sent it back to me with some prescribed letter on the prison letterhead. Sending simple things like that cut into their profit.

I speak of unfair sentencing of People of Color, about businesses within the prison systems, companies building their businesses closer to prisons so that prisoners can work there for less than a fraction of what they should be earning (Small - Sadler, 2007). I also refer to unequal sentencing of People of Color as opposed to sentences given to White offenders.

I am including many sources in this article to defend my thesis on the deliberate, conscious intent to destroy God chosen people by reporting to you what prisoners are paid, how they are viewed and how they are treated to show you what is happening to godly, non-violent people right here in the USA, the home of the free and the land of the brave.

All of this information included is from a multitude of sources so that you can see for yourself what the Pharaoh of 2007 is doing to your sons, daughters, husbands, neighbors, brothers or sisters, your country and to show you report after report of greed and intentional

maltreatment masked in the form of legalized slavery (Small - Sadler, 2007).

*The new Pharaoh of 2007 plans are fueled by hate, fear and greed (Small - Sadler, 2007).*

Coalition Against Injustice (CAI) represents many cases across America and reports that America has widespread corruption and injustice within the police departments, the judicial and penal systems and bar associations. They report a history of false accusation, and said that false testimony, wrongful convictions, are common. CAI alleges that all it takes are two or more false witnesses to convict someone of a crime. Not only does it affect the falsely accused and wrongfully convicted and their families, it affects every American.

CAI reports that America funds the corruption with our tax dollars. CAI feels that justice is available only to the rich and influential. The poor as well as people of Color cannot afford effective attorneys or investigators. CAI believes that Public defenders are ineffective counsel because they are paid by the state (the state is who prosecutes offenders). CAI goes on to say that police and prosecutors do lie, many police lie in court, (perjury), and prosecutors frequently lie. CAI states that Bad judges allow these crimes. Newspapers report what the prosecutor submits, so the public receives biased and frequently false information. The FBI refuses to send informants into prisons to help prove someone innocent, but WILL to prove a suspect guilty. Coalition Against Injustice believes the corruption increases as the public ignores, denies, covers up, and enables it. Many police are brutal. Too many upright police "honor their code of silence" because many are fearful of retaliation if they report it. The media is biased, censored, and frequently untruthful. CAI reports that mayors, governors, the FBI, the media, Congress, even presidents ignore, and frequently cover up the malfeasance, even though it is witnessed, documented, and confirmed continuously. More Americans must stand up and oppose the corruption! Expose it! Report it! Resist it! Demand JUSTICE! Coalition Against Injustice reports that Colorado has a history of police corruption and cover-ups.

### *Prison population*

According to the Source in US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Statistics, Prisoners in 1996 (Washington DC: US Department of Justice, 1997) over 80% of the increase in the federal prison population from 1985 to 1995 was due to drug convictions.

In the article written by Kathryn Casa (1999) entitled, Prisons a new growth industry in California, it reads that where lawmakers five years ago pioneered three-strikes laws that send people away for between 25 years to life for a third felony conviction, Sacramento Superior Court Judge Barry Loncke in an interview with the National Catholic Reporter said the state's sentencing criteria are so warped these days because of the political need to satisfy a public that seems unaware of the consequences of these mandatory - sentencing schemes.

Kathryn Casa (1999) reports that according to the latest Justice Department statistics, about 1.8 million people -- one out of every 150 Americans -- are behind bars. This population has doubled over the past 12 years.

As of June 30, 1998, more than 1.8 million people were locked up in the immense network of federal, state, and local prisons and jails (1). In total, more than 5.5 million people,

including those on probation and parole were directly under the surveillance of the criminal justice system. Additionally, more than 60 percent of the imprisoned population are People of Color.

Joan Petersilia, PhD. (2006) writes in "Understanding California Corrections" that California has the high recidivism rates in the US. Dr. Petersilia reports that although California spent more than \$7 billion on its correctional system in 2005–2006, it produced one of the highest recidivism rates in the nation. Dr. Petersilia goes on to say that total inmate population is at an all-time high of 168,350—a 3.5% increase in just one year—which has made prisons seriously overcrowded and compromised safety as well as the ability to deliver needed programs. Dr. Petersilia goes on to say that the State's approach to corrections is enormously expensive and enormously ineffective.

Wikipedia (November 2007) reports that The United States spends an estimated \$60 billion each year on corrections. The population of inmates housed in prisons and jails in the United States exceeds 2 million, with the per capita incarceration population higher than that officially reported by any other country. Because of its size and influence, the U.S. prison industry is often referred to as the prison-industrial complex. Criminal justice policy in the United States has also been criticized for the disproportionate representation of African Americans and other minorities.

In 1970, the state and federal prison population was under 190,000. Today, the same population is more than two million without counting persons on parole and probation. The total count is more than seven million persons in the criminal justice system alone (Alton H Maddox Jr., 2007).

The federal prison population continues to grow at a far more rapid rate than state prisons. With 57% of federal prisoners being incarcerated for drug offenses, this is largely due to the impact of federal mandatory minimum penalties. Projections by the Department of Justice in 2000 anticipated an increase of 50% in the total federal prison population by 2007 if current trends continue. Unless Congress reconsiders these policies, we can anticipate continued growth. The expansion of the federal prison population is also fueling the growth of the for-profit private prison industry, which houses more than one in ten federal prisoners.

According to Harrison, Paige M. & Allen J. Beck, The Department of Justice reported that at year-end 2003, federal prisons held a total of 158,426 inmates, of whom 86,972 (55%) were drug offenders. By comparison in 2000 federal prisons held 131,739 total inmates of whom 74,276 (56%) were drug offenders, and in 1995 federal prisons held a total of 88,658 inmates of whom 52,782 (60%) were drug offenders.

### *Slave Labor in Prison*

In an article entitled, "Prison Labor in Illinois it tells us that there is a new prison located in Joliet who employed a warden, who contracted with firms for a specified number of inmates to work at factories in the local community. In addition, the prison permitted private enterprises to set up privately run factories within the prison walls.

In an article written by Paul Wright (March 1997) Making slave labor fly and Boeing goes to prison [Excerpted from Prison Legal News], he reports that currently more than

90,000 state and federal convicts work in a variety of public and private enterprises while serving time. The majority are employed in state-owned enterprises such as making license plates or furniture for government offices. Increasingly, though, private businesses have contracted with at least 25 states to set up businesses inside prison walls to take advantage of state-supplied facilities and low-wage nonunion workers.

In an article Julie Browne (1995) wrote, entitled *The Labor of Doing Time*, she writes that slavery is being practiced by the system under the color of law.... Browne (1995) reports, "Slavery 400 years ago, slavery today, it's the same thing, but with a new name." They're making millions and millions of dollars enslaving Blacks, poor whites, and others people who don't even know they're being railroaded.

Julie Browne (1995) writes about Current Convict Labor Programs and reports that in the 1990s, the California Department of Corrections (CDoC) maintains that convict labor is only a peripheral program within the larger system confinement and punishment of convicts. However, the Prison Industry Authority (PIA) is a multi-million dollar industry that is dependent on the productivity of California prisoners. As inmates are classified for placement in an institution, they are surveyed for almost 50 different work skills, from appliance repair to x-ray technician, to determine which institution they should be placed in. (Prison Law Office, *The California State Prisoners Handbook*, Section 3.17, pp. 79-80.)

It is clear that the experience and work skills these offenders already have coming in the prisons argue against the claim that convict labor programs are for the furthering of the offenders job training and education.

Browne (1995) adds that there are four work/privilege classifications for prisoners: A classifications refers to full time work, B refers to half-time work/waiting list, C refers to refuses to work, D refers to special segregation unit prisoners. The prisoners who refuse to work, labeled as Group C, are not entitled to family visits, and are limited to one-fourth of the maximum monthly canteen draw. Telephone calls are permitted only on an emergency basis. These extreme coercive tactics contradict the claim that labor is voluntary.

Remembering the reason the prison system was developed and how it functions today, it is clear that this type of social control has been strongly connected to the institutionalization of bigotry, domination, labor misuse, and greed.

Alton H Maddox Jr. (2007) reports that those who fail to learn from the lessons of history are condemned to repeat them. Maddox said that Congress has the authority to prohibit private racial discrimination as a badge of slavery. This is the rule in the Thirteenth Amendment and it was made clear in *Jones v. Alfred H. Mayer Co.* Thus, Congress has the authority to ban private prisons. Penology is also a public function.

In the year 2000, Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker report that there are presently 80,000 inmates in the US employed in commercial activity, some earning as little as 21 cents an hour. The US government program Federal Prison Industries (FPI) currently employs 21,000 inmates, an increase of 14 percent in the last two years alone. FPI inmates make a wide variety of products—such as clothing, file cabinets, electronic equipment and military helmets—which are sold to federal agencies and private companies. FPI sales are \$600 million annually and rising, with over \$37 million in profits.

The pay of 21 cents an hour is ungodly and inhumane. Dogs are given more for their service than these inmates are and treated more humane than the inmates are reportedly treated (Small - Sadler, 2007).

I have a brother in the federal penitentiary who reports that he is paid once a month and his pay is 27 dollars a month. He said that sometimes he gets a bonus of 37 dollars. He reports that he pays the system/ penitentiary he is housed in 25 dollars every three months...

My brother reports that when he was on probation in 2002, he paid the probation officer \$50 a month until it was paid.

Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker (2000) report that during the last 20 years more than 30 states have passed laws permitting the use of convict labor by commercial enterprises. These programs now exist in 36 states.

Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker (2000) report that prisoners now manufacture everything from blue jeans, to auto parts, to electronics and furniture. Honda has paid inmates \$2 an hour for doing the same work an autoworker would get paid \$20 to \$30 an hour to do. Konica has used prisoners to repair copiers for less than 50 cents an hour. Toys R Us used prisoners to restock shelves, and Microsoft to pack and ship software. Clothing made in California and Oregon prisons competes so successfully with apparel made in Latin America and Asia that it is exported to other countries.

Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker (2000) research shows that Inmates are also employed in a wide variety of service jobs as well. TWA has used prisoners to handle reservations, while AT&T has used prison labor for telemarketing. In Oregon, prisoners do all the data entry and record keeping in the Secretary of State's corporation division. Other jobs include desktop publishing, digital mapping and computer-aided design work.

When you look at the information that Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker report you can see the greed and the deceit displayed here. It is easy to ascertain that if the prisoners are only paid \$2 an hour, the clothes and the other products produced should not be so expensive. This writer can only imagine the heightened profit margin all who are a part of this con are receiving. It makes one wonder when is enough really enough (Small - Sadler, 2007).

The prison system can provide a superlative workforce and employers do not have to pay health or unemployment insurance, vacation time, sick leave or overtime. They can hire, fire or reassign inmates as they so desire, and can pay the workers as little as 21 cents an hour. The inmates cannot respond with a strike, file a grievance, or threaten to leave and get a better job.

This writer insists that if we protest these practices by not buying goods, products, etc, the profit margin from the ungodly slavery of our people will end and the prisons will downsize because of profit decrease (Small - Sadler, 2007).

This research reported by Alan Whyte and Jamie Baker defines a criminal nature of these principalities that house inmates across this nation and calls for indictments to these so called, law biding citizens (Small - Sadler, 2007). Slavery was abolished in 1865 and what these ungodly people are doing now is trying to sneak slavery in through the back door and

get rich off People of Color in the process (Small - Sadler, 2007).

Beverly Scobel (1993) reports that the cost comparisons between probation and prison are dramatic and one of the strongest arguments for using probation as a sentencing option. Standard probation costs \$700 per offender per year, whereas keeping that offender in prison costs \$16,000 per year. Prison costs are exceptionally high and those costs are passed to the taxpayers, you and me.

These organizations are getting filthy rich off the poor Whites and the People of Color while we turn our weak heads the other way. Now doesn't this information sound just like what the Pharaoh of Bible days did to God's people (Small - Sadler, 2007)?

In an article entitled, "Drug Trafficking in Criminal Law" (2008) Associated Content, Inc. reports that Most offenders convicted of drug trafficking serve longer sentences than criminals convicted of violent crimes, including murder.

Drug Trafficking in Criminal Law (2008) wrote that the average prison sentence of a first-offense drug trafficking convict is three years, which is higher than those of most violent criminals, and the majority of drug trafficking convicts serve at least 80% of their sentences, while the average for violent offenders is only 50%.

Dave Bewley-Taylor, Mike Trace and Alex Stevens (2005) said that a snapshot of national incarceration figures and proportions of drug offenders calculated that in the early 1990s the cost of a prison place per year was more than the cost of tuition, room and board at Harvard. It has also been estimated that in 1996 the cost of a life sentence for a prisoner in California was \$1.5 million (Stern, 1998). High costs are not unique to the US.

Dave Bewley-Taylor, et.al (2005) report that A high level of spending on incarceration naturally generates opportunity costs to other areas of public expenditure. For example, research shows that in California and New York prison expenditure outstripped the budgets for higher education during the mid-1990s (Schiraldi, Holman & Beatty, 2000). In the US as a whole between 1987 and 1995 spending on corrections rose by 30%.

On elementary and secondary education spending fell by 1.2% and on higher education by 18.2% (Stern, 1998). By 1999 many states in the US were spending more on building prisons than colleges (Irwin, Schiraldi & Ziedenberg, 1999). The American sociologist, Elliot Currie concluded in 1993 that funds for prisons were diverted from parts of the public sector that educate, train, socialize, treat, house and nurture the population, especially the children of the poor (Currie, 1994).

Looking at Collateral Costs, Dave Bewley-Taylor, 2005 et. al) reports that It is likely that the diversion of funds to prisons has a deleterious impact upon many aspects of American society. It may even contribute to the creation of social conditions that lead some people to use illicit drugs.

Is this the reason there are so many lay offs, business closings and school closing, and homelessness? Is this why our economy is in a crash bang status, (foreclosures, bankruptcies) because more money is being used to lock up non-violent criminals for life than there is to support our economy (Small - Sadler, 2007)?

Imagine all the people America could employ, feed and house with the money currently being spent to make more jails and prison to needlessly, keep nonviolent offenders locked up in prison for life sentences. Imagine all the schools and businesses that could be reopened and financed if we were not buying Pharaoh's story of locking inmate up for ever for our safety (Small - Sadler, 2007).

There is so much evidence in this article to prove that there is a conspiracy to destroy People of Color after they have been worked to death, convinced that they are worthless and less than human, that this information found on these individual inflicting the ungodly sentences should be grounds for their incarceration.

After many families are broken up because People of Color cannot find suitable work and feel so hopeless that they feel short on options to support their families many turn to illegal activity (Small - Sadler, 2007).

Yes there is another choice, but for people who are hungry and low in Faith In God, those option are not clear because fear (Satan) is leading the actions they choose to take (Small - Sadler, 2007).

As a matter of fact, until these people enter the prison system and see how bad life can be, and how life would have been better if they had taken a job that paid low wages as opposed to the monthly income for prison work at 27 dollars a month or less they are unaware of the trap (Small - Sadler, 2007).

### *Private Prisons and Slavery*

In 1996, The Winds published an article that talks about Legalized Slavery. The article Slavery re instituted in America reads that the concept of slavery may seem far-fetched until one considers that it is legal and constitutional in the United States. The 13th amendment of the U.S. Constitution abolished involuntary servitude and chattel slavery of Africans, but an exception clause exists for those who have been convicted of a crime. The article reports that this exemption has been upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court on more than one occasion. Those convicted of a crime can be forced into slavery under the law, and big business is taking advantage of this human resource.

Even faster than the growing number of prisoners is the growing number of state and federal prisons that are run by private, for-profit corporations. The writer in The Winds (1996) reports that one such prison exists outside of Lockhart, Texas. The writer goes on to report that so far, Wackenhut has contracted with three companies who employ prisoners at their Lockhart facility. Leonard Hill relocated his company, Lockhart Technologies, Inc., from Austin to Wackenhut's prison, and he describes the benefits of prison labor in glowing terms. The Winds writer (1996) reports that 'Normally when you work in the free world', says Hill, 'you have people call in sick, they have car problems, they have family problems. We don't have that here.' Hill says the state pays for workers' compensation and medical care. And, he notes, inmates 'don't go on vacations.' Wackenhut doesn't do too bad either. After the government pays them \$31.00 a day per prisoner, they garnish 80 percent of the inmates' wages for room and board.

The Winds (1996) writer warns that anyone whose pension fund or investment portfolio

invests in prison construction bonds or who profits, either directly or indirectly, from the operation of prisons for profit, or who profits from the crime paranoia in general, will also be held strictly accountable. The crimes committed by those in prison are small compared to those who are profiting from the crime business.

In an article entitled, Prison Privatization and the Use of Incarceration (no author) it reports that today, the privatization of prisons refers both to the takeover of existing public facilities by private operators and to the building and operation of new and additional prisons by for-profit prison companies. (Many of the new prisons, additionally, are built to house out-of-state inmates.) Depending on the jurisdiction, the local, state, or federal government is then charged a per diem or monthly rate for each prisoner.

A source reports that the proliferation of prison labor for private profit has made escape on company time almost inevitable. Nearly 60 years after federal legislation outlawed the use of convict labor for interstate commerce, state governments and entrepreneurs are again teaming up to exploit prisoners. It is reported that politicians of both parties have jumped on the bandwagon, eager to be seen promoting the work ethic and private enterprise in prisons.

For workers, prison labor means lower wages: None of us can undersell workers who make 41 cents an hour and who get no workers' compensation, unemployment compensation or insurance costs -- not to mention health and safety protections.

Peter Gilmore reports that the Western Pen story is no aberration: More than 100 companies have contracted out the use of thousands of prisoners in at least 29 states. Arizona has already turned over the labor of 10 percent of its inmates to private businesses. Here are just a few examples of what is happening in prisons across the country:

Peter Gilmore writes that Inmates at the notorious Angola State Penitentiary in Louisiana have been de-boning chickens for 4 cents an hour for a private firm. Peter Gilmore also reports that a Washington company hired prisoners to wrap software for Microsoft. Gilmore said, "Golden arches, golden shackles? Oregon inmates produce electronic menu boards for McDonald's.

Corrections Corporation of America (CCA), the largest of the nation's 88 private prison operators, teamed up with Company Apparel Safety Items in the first partnership between a private prison and a private manufacturer (Peter Gilmore). Reports inform us that prisoners in South Carolina make lingerie for Victoria's Secret.

Gilmore tells us that the San Francisco-based computer firm DPAS closed its data retrieval operation in Mexico in 1994, and transferred the work to inmates of San Quentin prison. We have a captive labor force, a group of men who are dedicated and the whole thing is very profitable, says the owner of DPAS. Prison labor is the ultimate reliable workforce.

Prison privatization is now a galloping industry that has the support of everyone from Bill Clinton to the Republican right. Some of the country's biggest corporations are investing in the business, including American Express and Goldman Sachs & Co. Stock in CCA has quadrupled in the past four years. And these companies wield growing political clout: CCA, together with Thwacker Corrections Corp., gave almost \$150,000 in campaign contributions to Republicans and Democrats in 1995-96 (Peter Gilmore).

## *Business in the Bureau of Prisons*

United States penitentiaries receive monies from inmates, government and its taxpayers. There is also a growing boom within the prisons because they allow companies to move into the prison and set up their businesses using the prison inmates as employees (anonymous source . . . ).

Andrew Kramer, (2004) reports that Perry Johnson Inc., a Southfield, Mich.-based consulting company, chose to remain in the United States because he could open up his business in the Bureau of Prisons.

Perry Johnson Inc. opened its call center in an Oregon prison for half the price of relocating to India, and achieved many of the same benefits, according to Mike Reagan, director of Inside Oregon Enterprises at Snake River.

A prisoner who will remain nameless reports an earning of \$130 or so monthly working for Perry Johnson Inc. (Andrew Kramer, 2004).

Andrew Kramer goes on to write that Ten states, including Oregon, employ inmates in for-profit call centers. Oregon and many others also make garments and furniture--industries that have largely moved offshore, other than in prisons. Inmates are paid between 12 cents and \$5.69 an hour, according to Bureau of Prisons statistics.

Keeping offenders in jail costs a lot of money. States are now spending about \$25 billion a year on corrections. Caught between anti-tax agitation and anti-prisoner sentiment, a growing number of states are actually requiring prisoners to pay for their own incarceration.

Now these officials are sick and evil and add insult to injury. It is like asking inmates to pay to be enslaved and punished (Small - Sadler, 2007).

## *Growth in prison construction*

In the article entitled, Prison Construction is On the Rise, it reports that Phase I Construction at ASPC-Lewis Prison Construction is On the Rise (author unknown).

The article also reports that during the last 15 years, the Department has experienced a significant growth in prison construction with the addition of more than 12,000 beds. Arizona's growth in prison construction has been matched nationwide as other states have added as many as 40,000 new beds to their facilities. The trend reflected by these figures has ushered in a new stage of development for the Department. Future construction plans include adding an 800-bed prison at Yuma (Dakota) and a 4,150-bed prison at Buckeye (Lewis). With the addition of these beds, the Department will have more than doubled its inmate population during a 15-year time span.

## *What happens to ex-offender after release from prison?*

Researchers found 71 percent of the offenders surveyed expected to support themselves easily, although only 15 percent had jobs waiting for them. Most acknowledged they would need help with education, job training, money, transportation and health care (by

Gritsforbreakfast).

The study also found that 79 percent expected it to be easy to renew family relationships. As many as 63 percent expected to live with their families and 54 percent said they would rely on loved ones for financial support (Gritsforbreakfast).

That's an incredible amount of optimism and positive, hopeful potential offenders appear to possess when they leave the penitentiary. It's too bad reality doesn't more closely reflect their expectations. If 71% think they'll support themselves, but only 15% have jobs waiting, then about 56% are in for a big disappointment. So many employers refuse to hire ex-prisoners, they'll be lucky to draw any paycheck at all in the free world, much less one that lets them support themselves and their families (Gritsforbreakfast).

Because of the court systems, judges, prosecutors, etc. these men and women coming out of prison face insurmountable odds. Ex-offenders records of past offenses follow them everywhere they go whether it is in their home or neighborhood.

Many ex-offenders seek employment with very few willing to hire them or show them trust. No one seems to have the courage it takes to give people with felony records a chance to prove they are capable of change. Ex-offenders looking for rental properties can be even tougher. Then they go back to their old ways, back to a known behavior and end up back in prison.

We have got to do better than this. Remember God is watching us and He is not pleased with the way we treat ex offenders, especially our own family. It could be you or me and one day it may just be you or me needing help. Don't miss out on the opportunity to help our fallen family member or the Lord may show us the hard way what it is like to need someone to believe and trust in as we a ledge that we are working on change and just need someone to believe in us and support through this time of need (Small - Sadler, 2007).

One of the authors of the study, Nancy La Vigne said, I really do believe ex offenders have every hope and every intent of making it this time. The disconnect comes after release, when they have no support system.

The writer of The Never ending debt to the Criminal Justice System, Ezekiel Edwards (Oct 09, 2007) wrote, as a public defender in the Bronx, I was amazed to see the courts impose fine after fine, surcharge after surcharge, program cost after program cost, on my clients, despite the fact that they came from the poorest families in one of the poorest counties in the United States. It seemed counterproductive to put the poorest people under even greater financial pressure, and at even steeper pecuniary disadvantages, which only further severed their chances at economic mobility, deprived their families and children of much-needed support, added to their sense of inadequacy and at times humiliation, and increased their rates of recidivism. Those who could not pay fines, restitution, or for programs were sent back to jail. Those that could not pay surcharges would see their credit history shredded, thereby significantly dimming their future prospects of gaining approval for securing loans, buying or renting apartments or cars, etc.

Policies that only serve to keep poor people poor come at a high cost to all involved, including the taxpayers who must support an overburdened criminal justice system that

imprisons over 2.3 million people, must change. Hopefully the Justice Center's report will begin that change Ezekiel Edwards (October 2007).

As reported earlier, it is hard for ex offenders to find jobs and when there is trouble with the family support system they are discouraged and it leads them to lose the little faith in God they do have (Small - Sadler, 2007).

When that happens ex offenders try to go it alone without God. That is the Pharaoh of 2007's cue to enter their minds and deceive them and cause them to doubt God.

They listen to the Pharaoh of 2007's counsel and try things his way again, because of lack of patience and faith in God. They are too impatient and weak to wait on God (Small - Sadler, 2007).

If ex offenders cannot find jobs and their family don't have resources necessary to help them, the ex offenders will do whatever it takes to survive (Small - Sadler, 2007).

*There are five times in Scripture where the phrase little Faith is used:*

1. Matthew 6:30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall He not much more clothe you, O ye of little Faith?

2. Luke 12:28 If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and tomorrow is cast into the oven; how much more will He clothe you, O ye of little Faith?

3. Matthew 8:26 And He saith unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little Faith? Then He arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.

4. Matthew 16:8 Which when Jesus perceived, He said unto them, O ye of little Faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread?

5. Matthew 14:31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth His hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little Faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

## *Conclusion*

The bitter, hard bondage of Pharaoh of 2007 has a different platform as it did in the Bible days and when African Americans were first taken from their home in Africa, but the same results (Small - Sadler, 2007).

The bitter, hard bondage of Pharaoh of 2007 is defined as the jails, penitentiaries, employers that refuse to pay People of Color livable wages, some wardens, directors, guards, some politicians, lawmakers and governments (Small - Sadler, 2007).

In the article, Prisons are Like Airlines the writer reveals that, Throughout January and February, legislators, wardens and county supervisors deluged the corrections department with pleas for prisoners. Mr. Johnson had no qualms about putting criminals behind bars. He had done it for most of his career as a cop. But it disturbed him to hear burglars, drug dealers and car thieves being portrayed as valuable assets.

Joseph Delius writer of Prisons a booming industry in the US and Europe reports that some in the US states are already spending considerably more on their prison systems than on higher education. This could provide a very winnable election for a Democratic candidate and republicans alike. There are millions of People of Color who vote that have family members in prisons, on probation or in half way houses. Prisons are paid for with tax dollars. Yes, tax dollars that could and should be applied to keep all of the schools that are closing down open (Small - Sadler, 2007).

With these tax dollars being used erroneously (i.e. . . . for building more prisons) it could be more useful for housing the homeless, financing Small Businesses for People of Color, support programs for the elderly and the mentally ill clients who were released from the places they use to call home (Small - Sadler, 2007).

The new Pharaoh knows all of this. However he is busy planting fear in God's people of America so they are blinded by fear. Most inmates are not violent, they've just made some poor choices (Small - Sadler, 2007).

These poor choices are based on how they see the current majority living their lives.

The current majority kids don't have to wear hand me down, or thrift store clothes or eats day old food. The current majority doesn't have to take lower wages or live in government run down houses.

Because of the Color of our skin we are paid less, hired last and thought of as less than human, not by most people but by many people, especially those in power. Not all, but many of the people in power view People of the Color as cattle, slaves, ignorant and as less than human (Small - Sadler, 2007).

Non violent offenders don't sell drugs, or commit crime for pleasure. NO they do these crimes although they are illegal and wrong, they do this to feed their families and provide a decent home for them (Small - Sadler, 2007).

In the article entitled, Reparations for African American Slavery this author explains that

the text is not meant to blame white people for all of the problems African Americans and other People of Color face (no author) . . .

However, it is meant to inform all people of what money hungry, greedy, heartless people are capable of inflicting on loving, kind, and trusting people. This is of Pharaoh of 2007 and Satan, and not of a complete racial matter.

Remember that not all White people are racist. This Article was written to inform, not to separate us or spread hatred. In my experience there are more good White people than bad. Embrace your heritage, learn the truth about who we were and still are. We are strong, intelligent, creative, talented, proud people. Although in slavery time it was illegal for Black people to be read that is no longer the case.

Now look at all that we are able to accomplish with so many odds against us . . . We are Conquerors through Christ Jesus. Remember God's Word said, that the meek will inherit the earth. That time is almost at hand. Look at the population growth among People of Color!

Take classes that are available to you while you are in prison and when you are released from prison get a good education! Read everything! Read God's Word, Pray, trust God, He will Direct your path. Ask God to Guide you and God will do just that. God Loves all of us. Don't measure God's Love by the material, Measure God's Love by the Eternal (Linda Small - Sadler, 2007).

The difference in the the male children destroyed in Bible days and the men today is that men of Color are in jail and someone else is raising their children. Their children are in gangs, hooked on drugs, on their way to jail or the grave. It is a more silent, yet ordered form or destruction and death as well as slavery (Small - Sadler, 2007).

Remember the story, A new Pharaoh arises in Egypt who did not know Joseph. Pharaoh feared that the Israelites would continue to multiply and become more powerful than the Egyptians, so he appoints taskmasters over the Israelites and enslaves them. That was a mistake. If this Pharaoh had taken the time to get to know the Living God and His people he would have made a Godly choice and trusted God's people to not take over his little kingdom.

God was very patient with Pharaoh and gave Pharaoh plenty of opportunities to repent and in the end God simply showed Pharaoh that God is God.

God had judged Egypt in its treatment of Israel and started a punishment cycle. Had Egypt responded (like the People of Color), the catastrophes would have been averted because God always provides Grace (Linda Small - Sadler, 2007).

Free will can be a Blessing it we choose based on God's Word and Commandments. We believe that People of Color are being used to keep this most evil industry in a high-growth mode. How is this being done? Jack Crawford and Sanford Jackson report that this is being done through DRUGS!!

Jack Crawford and Sanford Jackson question the reasoning behind why the government would choose to incarcerate so many people for nonviolent drug offenses, target minorities, refuse to seriously deal with the need for rehabilitation of drug-addicted people, build so many prisons and do next to nothing to really stop the flow of drugs into the country (if the US really felt that drugs threatened its interests the Marines would have visited Columbia and Bolivia a long time ago). I can only conclude that this is a long-term plan to eradicate People of Color, especially our men and it's working right here in America.

It's time to wake up and pull the alarm. We must decriminalize cocaine, heroin and especially marijuana. The health risks are minuscule in comparison to the legal drugs like cigarettes and alcohol. Illegal drugs kill 10-20,000 people annually plus the attendant misery of murder, war and family pain caused by prison, death and community disruption (theft, robbery, etc.). Cigarettes kill 400,000+ people annually in the US. Alcohol-related deaths in traffic accidents kill 50,000 people each year. So who are the criminals (Jack Crawford and Sanford Jackson)?

If lawmakers and legal officers allow these drugs to be sold in liquor stores next to the alcoholic beverages, which kill far more people than drugs kill we would be able to close the prisons, because the drug dealers and traffickers would have to go out of business. This change would stop this movement toward genocide (Small - Sadler, 2007).

According to an article written by Mokdad, Ali H., PhD, James S. Marks, MD, Donna F. Stroup, PhD, MSc, Julie L. Gerberding, MD, MPH, on "Actual Causes of Death in the United States" results show that leading causes of death in 2000 were tobacco (435 000 deaths; 18.1% of total US deaths), poor diet and physical inactivity (400 000 deaths; 16.6%), and alcohol consumption (85 000 deaths; 3.5%). Other actual causes of death were microbial agents (75 000), toxic agents (55 000), motor vehicle crashes (43 000), incidents involving firearms (29 000), sexual behaviors (20 000) and illicit use of drugs (17 000).

In other words records show that there are more deaths from Tobacco, Poor diet and physical inactivity, Alcohol consumption and microbial agents than reported from drug deaths.

With this in mind will lawmaker lock up all of the people that use or sell Tobacco, or Alcohol or those with Poor diet and physical inactivity, or those with Microbial agents (Small - Sadler, 2007)?

The answer is no they will not arrest them mainly because there is not large profit in that and many of these people are not God's Chosen people (Small - Sadler, 2007)...

According to ONDCP, federal spending to incarcerate drug offenders totals nearly \$3 Billion A YEAR -- \$2.525 Billion by the Bureau of Prisons, and \$429.4 Million by Federal

Prisoner Detention. Source: Office of National Drug Control Policy, National Drug Control Strategy: FY 2003 Budget Summary (Washington, DC: Office of the President, February 2002), Table 3, pp. 7-9.

Sentencingproject.org website writes that Changes in sentencing law and policy, not increases in crime rates, explain most of the six-fold increase in the national prison population. These changes have significantly impacted racial disparities in sentencing, as well as increased the use of one size fits all mandatory minimum sentences that allow little consideration for individual characteristics.

Wikipedia (November 2007) reports that Some have criticized the United States for having a high amount of non-violent and victimless offenders incarcerated. Half of all persons incarcerated under state jurisdiction are for non-violent offenses, and 20% are incarcerated for drug offenses. Human Rights Watch believes the extraordinary rate of incarceration in the United States wrecks havoc on individuals, families and communities, and saps the strength of the nation as a whole.

Reports show that there are 1.96 million U.S. children who have a parent or other close relative in jail or prison. In addition, one out of three young African-American males are under some form of criminal justice supervision. So the father or the mother are not in the home to help teach the children good family values.

Do you see the evil conspiracy that is unfolding here. They are trying to change God's Word, by invoking unfair long sentences for mostly People of Color. Not only are they destroying families but also they are getting filthy rich in the process. This is also putting a strain on the US economy (Small - Sadler, 2007).

According to reports, there are more prisons being built and a projection of more scheduled to be built with the expectation of a full population of new prisoners who have not been arrested yet.

In this prediction this author reads that they are expecting people to be arrested who have not committed a crime yet (Small - Sadler, 2007). It is almost like a housing market because builders build new homes all over the world with no guarantee buyers will purchase all of the homes built. However because of probabilities based on past actions, builders know that eventually all of the home will be purchased.

The same logic is used for the new prison construction because forecasters and the new Pharaoh believe they will fill all of the prison being built now with future inmates.

That is very sad news for prisoners and their families and very greedy and evil of the prison builders (Small - Sadler, 2007). The new Pharaoh of 2007 believes that more people will be convicted of crimes and locked up whether these are valid convictions or not (Small - Sadler, 2007).

It is so ironic to this writer that in some cases, murderers have been given parole or shorter sentences.

In an article written By Randall Mikkelsen Mon (Dec 31, 2007) he report in WASHINGTON (Reuters) that Sara Jane Moore, one of two women who tried to assassinate President Gerald Ford in a three-week span in 1975, was freed on parole on Monday after almost 32 years in prison, a government spokesman said.

October 29, 1994: Francisco Martin Duran fired at least 29 shots with a semi-automatic rifle at the White House from Pennsylvania Avenue, outside the south lawn, thinking that Bill Clinton was among the men in dark suits standing there (Clinton was in the White House Residence watching a football game). No one was hurt and Duran was sentenced to 40 years in prison.

These are just a few people who tried to kill leaders of our country. They committed a violent crime and were given smaller sentences than many non-violent offenders are given. There is a very powerful, unfair, ungodly message being sent to Americans. That message is that an alleged non-violent offenders crime are more heinous that someone who attempts to kill the most highest official in America, our president! Our Commander and Chief!!!

*What will we do to change unfair sentencing laws that target mostly People of Color?*

Like so many People of Color my brother was given life with no possibility of parole for a non-violent crime for alleged drug sales. How long will this continue?

Kathryn Casa (1999) reports that in cases where mandatory minimums apply for drug offenses, a 1992 Federal Judicial Center report found that there has always been a tendency for the sentences of whites to be lower than the sentences of non-whites, a difference that, unfortunately, has become larger over time. The average sentence for African-Americans was 28 percent higher in 1984 than for whites. That gap dropped to 11 percent in 1986, but since then it has steadily increased. By 1990, the average sentence for Blacks was 49 percent higher than for whites.

America's citizens pay thousands of dollars, per inmate, but the inmates still have to work, pay rent, pay for Dr. visits, toiletries, snacks, radios, postage, restitution, crime-victim's compensation and many more things. Full-time employment at inmate wages is so low it is a disgrace.

In Bible day the wonderful increase of God's chosen people was according to the promise long before made unto the fathers. Though the performances of God's promises seem slow to us, it is always sure.
